



## Mission Trip to Anapra Mexico to Serve the Colegio Susana Wesley

**Trip Dates:** June 13-20, 2020

### The Details

- Travel
  - Flying from Columbus to El Paso, TX to then cross the border into Mexico via car/van.
  - Passport: you will need a passport that will not expire within 6 months of our departure. It can take 6 weeks to process a passport application.

- Accommodations
  - We will stay at a house in Anapra with the Briones, the missionaries who founded the school.
  - There are multiple rooms that we will share that have bunk beds.
  - There are two bathrooms equipped with showers on site for our use.
- Food
  - The majority of meals will be prepared in Anapra at the house.
  - Breakfast: We typically go shopping early in the week for some breakfast foods (cereal, milk, breakfast bars, fruit).
  - Lunch & dinner: are traditional Mexican meals prepared on site with bottled water for our safety.
  - You will have the opportunity to purchase your own snacks at the local grocery store.
- Costs
  - Participants will pay \$750. This includes your flight, your housing, and your food while we are in Anapra. A non-refundable deposit of \$50 is due by January 26. A second installment of \$350 is due by March 1 and final payment of \$350 is due by April 5. Payment plans and scholarships are available.   - Checked bags: We will be flying American Airlines which does charge for checked luggage. You will want to budget for bags you will want to check. Currently, they charge \$30 for the first bag, \$40 for the second, and \$150 for the third bag.
  - Spending money: You will also need to bring some spending money for meals while we are traveling (airport) as well as any money for souvenirs, usually around \$100.
